#### Mail In Ballots:

The Board of Elections has mailed a postcard reminder to all voters who were mailed a “Replacement” ballot encouraging them to vote the “Replacement” ballot. Even if you mailed the original ballot into the office, vote the “Replacement” ballot to replace the original ballot.

#### Ways to return your ballot:

There are 35 drop box locations to return your voted “Replacement” ballot. The attached link displays the location of those Boxes - [Voter Information | Baltimore City](#)

You can also return your ballot by mail if it is post marked by June 23, 2026, 5:00pm. *(have your local post office date stamp your ballot before returning)*. The Board encourages you to use 1 of the 35 drop boxes. You can also drop your voted “mail in ballot” at a vote center or your polling location on Election Day.

**Reminder** - If you decide to vote at an Early Voting Center or your polling place instead of returning the mail-in ballot, please know you will have to vote a provisional ballot, which will be canvassed after Election Day. Accordingly, the Board encourages you to return the “Replacement” ballot.

You can track the status of your returned “Replacement” ballot by accessing the Baltimore City Board of Elections website at: <https://www.baltimorecity.gov/boe> and click “Voter Lookup/Track your Ballot”

**For those rare circumstances where a voter will not be available to receive and then return the “Replacement” ballot, their first returned mail-in ballot will be canvassed and counted (as long as it is the correct party ballot for the voter).**

**Registration Deadline:** The deadline to register and change party affiliation was June 2, 2026. Party affiliation changes will resume starting July 7, 2026.
